VEGETABLE CROP	HELPFUL HERBS	HELPFUL FLOWERS	WHY THEY HELP
 Tomatoes	Basil, Chives, Parsley, Thyme	Marigolds, Nasturtiums, Borage	• attracts pollinators • supports beneficial insects • helps repel pests
 Peppers	Basil, Oregano, Chives, Thyme	Marigolds, Zinnias, Nasturtiums	• attracts pollinators • deters harmful pests • pairs well in mixed beds
 Cucumbers	Dill, Chives, Basil, Parsley	Nasturtiums, Borage, Sunflowers	• supports pollinators • deters pests • good around edges
 Beans	Dill, Thyme, Rosemary, Chives	Marigolds, Alyssum, Sunflowers	• attracts beneficial insects • improves pollination • supports healthy growth
 Squash	Dill, Basil, Oregano	Nasturtiums, Marigolds, Borage	• repels pests • attracts pollinators • good ground cover nearby
 Brassicas (Broccoli, Kale, Cabbage)	Dill, Thyme, Rosemary, Chives	Alyssum, Marigolds, Calendula	• attracts beneficial insects • improves pollination • deters cabbage pests
 Lettuce	Chives, Dill, Parsley	Calendula, Alyssum, Pansies	• attracts pollinators • deters aphids • pairs well in mixed beds
 Carrots	Chives, Thyme, Parsley, Dill	Alyssum, Marigolds, Calendula	• repels carrot pests • attracts beneficial insects • good around edges
