 Tomatoes	Basil, Carrots, Onions, Garlic, Marigolds, Asparagus	Cabbage, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Fennel, Dill, Walnut
 Basil	Tomatoes, Peppers, Oregano, Asparagus, Marigolds	Rue, Fennel
 Carrots	Onions, Leeks, Tomatoes, Peas, Radishes, Rosemary	Dill, Parsley
 Onions	Carrots, Lettuce, Peas, Beets, Tomatoes, Chamomile	Peas, Beans, Sage
 Beans (Pole & Bush)	Corn, Cucumber, Squash, Carrots, Radishes, Marigolds	Onions, Garlic, Fennel
 Cucumbers	Beans, Peas, Dill, Radishes, Sunflowers, Marigolds	Potatoes, Sage, Aromatic Herbs (except Dill)
 Lettuce	Radishes, Carrots, Strawberries, Cucumbers, Chives	Celery, Parsley
 Peppers	Tomatoes, Basil, Onions, Carrots, Spinach, Marigolds	Fennel, Kohlrabi
 Cabbage	Dill, Celery, Onions, Beets, Chamomile	Strawberries, Tomatoes, Grapes
 Spinach	Strawberries, Peas, Cauliflower, Broccoli, Onions	Leeks, Strawberries
 Strawberries	Lettuce, Spinach, Borage, Onions, Thyme, Marigolds	Cabbage, Broccoli, Cauliflower
 Corn	Beans, Squash, Pumpkins, Sunflowers	Tomatoes, Celery
 Peas	Carrots, Radishes, Turnips, Corn, Cucumbers	Onions, Garlic, Peppers
