1. Tomatoes	Basil, Carrots, Onions, Garlic, Marigolds, Nasturtiums	Cabbage, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Fennel, Dill	Improves flavor; repels pests (hornworms, aphids); attracts beneficial insects	_____
2. Peppers	Basil, Onions, Carrots, Spinach, Marigolds	Fennel, Kohlrabi	Repels pests; enhances growth and yields	_____
3. Cucumbers	Dill, Nasturtiums, Radishes, Beans, Marigolds	Aromatic herbs (Sage, Rosemary), Potatoes	Repels pests; attracts pollinators; improves vigor	_____
4. Beans (Bush/Pole)	Corn, Cucumber, Squash, Radishes, Marigolds	Onions, Garlic, Fennel	Nitrogen fixation; supports growth of heavy feeders	_____
5. Carrots	Onions, Leeks, Garlic, Tomatoes, Radishes	Dill	Repels carrot rust fly; improves flavor	_____
6. Lettuce	Radishes, Carrots, Strawberries, Cucumbers, Chives	Celery, Parsley	Improves growth; makes efficient use of space	_____
7. Onions	Carrots, Beets, Lettuce, Tomatoes, Chamomile	Beans, Peas, Sage	Repels pests (aphids, carrot flies); improves flavor	_____
8. Garlic	Tomatoes, Roses, Fruit Trees, Carrots, Lettuce	Beans, Peas	Natural pest repellent; helps prevent fungal diseases	_____
9. Basil	Tomatoes, Peppers, Lettuce, Oregano, Asparagus	Rue	Enhances flavor; repels flies, mosquitoes, and aphids	_____
10. Marigolds	Tomatoes, Peppers, Beans, Cucumbers, Squash	Cabbage (may stunt growth)	Repels nematodes and many garden pests; attracts beneficial insects	_____
11. Corn	Beans, Squash, Cucumbers, Pumpkins, Sunflowers	Tomatoes (close), Celery	Beans add nitrogen; squash shades soil and retains moisture	_____
12. Squash	Corn, Nasturtiums, Beans, Radishes, Marigolds	Potatoes	Repels pests; soil coverage reduces weeds and retains moisture	_____
13. Herbs (General)	Most vegetables, especially Tomatoes, Carrots, Cabbage, Peppers	—	Attract pollinators; repel pests; improve plant health	_____
14. Strawberries	Borage, Beans, Lettuce, Spinach, Onions	Cabbage	Borage deters pests; onions reduce fungal issues	_____
15. Potatoes	Beans, Corn, Cabbage, Horseradish, Marigolds	Tomatoes, Pumpkins, Squash	Repels pests; improves disease resistance	_____

KEY TO TERMS



Nitrogen Fixation

Plants (usually legumes) that add nitrogen to the soil, benefiting neighboring plants.



Pest Repellent

Plants that help deter harmful insects, nematodes, or other pests naturally.



Attracts Beneficials

Plants that attract pollinators or beneficial insects that support a healthy garden.



Improves Growth

Plants that enhance growth, flavor, or yield when grown together.
