PLANTS THAT SUPPORT EACH OTHER

	TOMATOES	♥	BASIL, CARROTS, ONIONS
	CARROTS	♥	ONIONS, LEEKS, ROSEMARY
	BEANS	♥	CORN, CUCUMBERS, RADISHES
	CORN	♥	BEANS, SQUASH, PUMPKINS
	CUCUMBERS	♥	DILL, NASTURTIUMS, BEANS
	LETTUCE	♥	RADISHES, CARROTS, STRAWBERRIES
	BRASSICAS (CABBAGE, BROCCOLI, KALE)	♥	DILL, CHAMOMILE, CELERY, ONIONS
	PEPPERS	♥	BASIL, ONIONS, CARROTS
	STRAWBERRIES	♥	BORAGE, LETTUCE, SPINACH
	MARIGOLDS	♥	TOMATOES, PEPPERS, CABBAGE

These pairings can improve growth, repel pests, and boost yields!

PLANTS THAT CONFLICT

	TOMATOES	≠	FENNEL, CABBAGE, WALNUTS
	BEANS	≠	ONIONS, GARLIC, FENNEL
	CARROTS	≠	DILL, PARSLEY
	CUCUMBERS	≠	POTATOES, SAGE
	LETTUCE	≠	CELERY, PARSLEY
	CORN	≠	TOMATOES, CELERY, PEPPERS
	ONIONS	≠	PEAS, BEANS
	POTATOES	≠	TOMATOES, PUMPKINS, CUCUMBERS
	PEPPERS	≠	FENNEL, KOHLRABI
	HERBS (BASIL)	≠	RUE (HERB), SAGE (IN EXCESS)
