TOMATO

Basil, Marigold, Onion,
Carrot, Asparagus



CARROT

Onion, Leek, Radish,
Rosemary, Sage



LETTUCE

Radish, Carrot, Strawberry,
Chives



CUCUMBER

Nasturtium, Dill, Peas,
Marigold



BEANS (BUSH/POLE)

Corn, Cucumber, Squash,
Marigold



PEPPERS

Basil, Onion, Carrot,
Marigold



CABBAGE FAMILY

(Cabbage, Broccoli, Kale)
Celery, Dill, Chamomile,
Rosemary



CORN

Beans, Squash, Pumpkin,
Sunflower

★ TIPS

- Plant flowers like Marigold, Nasturtium, and Alyssum to attract beneficial insects.
- Keep good air flow and spacing to reduce disease.
- Rotate crops each season to improve soil health.
