VEGETABLES		GOOD COMPANIONS	AVOID	BENEFITS
	TOMATOES	Basil, Carrots, Marigold, Onions, Garlic	Cabbage, Broccoli, Fennel, Walnut	Improves flavor, repels pests, supports growth
	LETTUCE	Carrots, Radishes, Strawberries, Chives	Celery, Parsley	Shades soil, reduces weeds, attracts beneficial insects
	PEPPERS	Basil, Onions, Carrots, Cilantro, Marigold	Fennel, Kohlrabi	Repels aphids, improves yield, enhances flavor
	CUCUMBERS	Nasturtiums, Dill, Beans, Radishes, Sunflowers	Potatoes, Aromatic Herbs (Sage, Rosemary)	Repels pests, supports pollination, maximizes space
	BEANS	Corn, Cucumbers, Squash, Radishes, Marigold	Onions, Garlic, Fennel	Fixes nitrogen, improves growth, repels pests
	CABBAGE	Dill, Celery, Chamomile, Nasturtiums	Strawberries, Tomatoes, Peppers	Deters cabbage pests, improves flavor, supports growth

HERBS		GOOD COMPANIONS	AVOID	BENEFITS
	BASIL	Tomatoes, Peppers, Oregano, Asparagus	Rue	Improves flavor, repels flies and mosquitoes
	ROSEMARY	Carrots, Beans, Cabbage, Sage	Cucumbers, Squash	Repels cabbage moths and carrot flies
	THYME	Cabbage, Broccoli, Tomatoes, Rosemary	—	Enhances growth, repels pests, attracts beneficial insects
	CHIVES	Carrots, Tomatoes, Roses, Apples	Beans, Peas	Repels aphids and Japanese beetles, supports growth
	CILANTRO	Tomatoes, Peppers, Onions, Carrots	Fennel	Attracts beneficial insects, improves growth
	MINT	Cabbage, Tomatoes, Herbs, Fruit Trees	—	Repels ants, aphids, and flea beetles, spreads beneficial scent

FLOWERS		GOOD COMPANIONS	AVOID	BENEFITS
	MARIGOLD	Tomatoes, Peppers, Beans, Cabbage	—	Repels nematodes, aphids, and whiteflies
	NASTURTium	Cucumbers, Squash, Beans, Tomatoes	—	Repels aphids, attracts pollinators, edible leaves and flowers
	CALENDULA	Tomatoes, Cabbage, Herbs, Peppers	—	Repels pests, reduces nematodes, supports soil health
	BORAGE	Tomatoes, Strawberries, Squash, Herbs	—	Attracts pollinators, improves fruit set, repels tomato hornworms
	ALYSSUM	Cabbage, Lettuce, Carrots, Strawberries	—	Attracts beneficial insects, suppresses weeds

Good Companions: Plants that help each other grow, repel pests, or improve flavor.



Avoid: Plants that may compete, inhibit growth, or attract harmful pests.
